The Gaucha Translations Training has been approved by the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to train HCIs from May 25, 2021 to June 10, 2021.

During the training period, the organization agrees to:

- Make this written notice of OHA approval available to any student or partnering organization that requests a copy and, to the extent possible, display this notice at the main training facility.
- Issue a certificate of completion that includes the start and end date to all successful program students.
- Report to OHA changes to the program/training within 30 days of the decision to make the change.
- Apply for training program renewal at least 6 months prior to the expiration of approval.
- Allow OHA to conduct training program site visits during the approval period or renewal process.
